

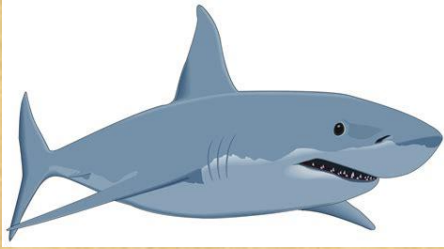

Welcome to Year 5 at Thameside Primary School

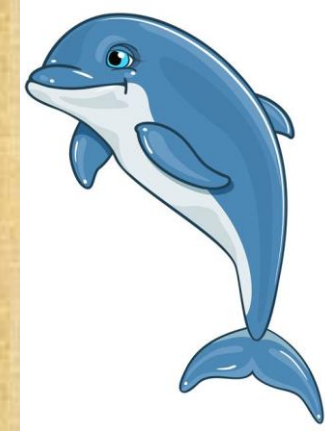
- ▶ We would like to welcome you to Year Five at Thameside Primary School. We are ready to help you and your child embark upon the next part of their learning journey.

The school day

A typical school day:

- ▶ School gates open **before 8.45am**
- ▶ Gates close at 8.55am and the register is taken. Children arriving after the doors have closed will need to be signed in at the office and will be marked as late.
- ▶ Early work starts at 8.45am.
- ▶ Lunch Break starts at 12:30pm and finishes at 1.30pm
- ▶ 1.30pm - The afternoon typically includes wider curriculum lessons.
- ▶ School ends at 3.15p.m.

Please help your child by quizzing them, letting them quiz you, asking them to redraw diagrams or finding other fun ways to help them commit this information to their long term memory.
- ▶ Once a term, we will set an Own work project related to our topic.
- ▶ Once a week on the school newsletter there will be a question for you to discuss with your child to help support their learning

Every night
